Dr. Dennis Thompson brings enthusiasm and high energy to his practical presentations of day-to-day implant and periodontal procedures. In addition to being board certified by the American Board of Periodontology and a fellow of the American College of Dentistry, Dr. Thompson is an associate professor in the Department of Surgical Dentistry (periodontics) at the University of Colorado. His credentials include a Bachelor of Science and Doctor of Dental Surgery degrees from the University of Minnesota. He received his certificate in periodontics, as well as a Master of Science in Education from the University of Iowa. While maintaining a practice limited to periodontics and implant dentistry, he also devotes several days per month to teaching and clinical research. Dr. Thompson has published articles in the Journal of Periodontology, the Journal of Clinical Periodontology, and Implant Dentistry. He has served on the scientific advisory board for Phillips/Sonicare and GlaxoSmithKline, and he is currently a clinical advisor and lecturer for DENTSPLY Tulsa Dental Specialties, the Perio Institute, and the Las Vegas Institute. He is founder and co-director of the Periodontal Research Institute that serves to foster better understanding of periodontal diseases through ongoing clinical studies.

Restoration of Lost Ridges: • How to add both horizontal & vertical dimension • When is 2 stage procedure necessary. • How to preserve periosteum. Violations of Maxillary Sinus: • How to use biocompatible graft materials and be confident of quality closure. • Use of flowable graft material with osteotome to lift floor
